

## Cookie Policy

*This document describes the principles of using cookies on the <https://tgth.pl> website, the operator of which is TGTH sp. z o.o. with its seat in Warsaw, Poland (hereinafter "Together"). More information regarding how Together process data within the website can be found in the Privacy Policy.*

### 1. General information about cookies

- Cookies are small data packets, usually in text form, that are available or stored on user's terminal device. The purpose of them is to make the use of websites more efficient, effective or convenient. Cookies do not change the configuration of user's terminal devices or the software of these devices. They enable the identification of the computer and the browser used by the computer
- Cookies may be stored on user's terminal devices temporarily ("session cookies") or until the cookies expire or are deleted ("persistent cookies").
- Together' website uses the following types of cookies:

A) strictly necessary cookies, that are used for activities that are strictly necessary to operate or deliver the service user requested from Together and, therefore, do not require user to consent;

B) basic interactions & functionality cookies, that enable basic interactions and functionalities that allow users to access selected features of our service and facilitate communication with Together;

C) experience enhancement cookies, that enable a personalized user experience by improving the quality of user's preference management options, and by enabling the interaction with external networks and platforms;

D) measurement cookies, that enable to measure traffic and analyze user's behavior with the goal of improving this service;

E) targeting & advertising cookies, that enable delivery of personalized marketing content to users, based on user's behavior and enable to operate, serve and track ads.

### 2. Website settings

The user has the right to withdraw prior given consent to the use of cookies by Together' website. It is possible to do so by changing cookie settings.

### 3. Third-party providers of cookies used on the Together' website

Together' website uses cookies from the following third party providers:

4.1. Google LLC, 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA offering Google Analytics tools. Google Analytics collect anonymous information about user's visits to the websites (pages opened, pages viewed, time spent on the websites, etc.) in order to generate statistics about the operation of the websites. If user does not agree to the use of Google Analytics tools, user can delete their cookies in all browsers based on the information available at: <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>.
